1) Prizes and Giveaways

- a. Top 3 teams in the 23&U Women, Women Open, Mixed Open and Corporate Mixed Open categories will be awarded with the following cash prizes:
 - 1st Place - \$1000**
 - 2nd Place - \$400**
 - 3rd Place - \$200**
- b. Top 3 teams in the Women Social and Schools/Clubs categories will be awarded 12 medals each.
- c. One set of Bibs will be provided, and teams are **required** to wear them for all matches.
- d. An event photo booth will be available where participants can bring back instant photo souvenirs.

2) Exhibition Match

- a. There is Charity Exhibition Match on 23 August 2025, 10.00am (*timing subject to change*). This is by invitation only. Deloitte will donate \$500 for every goal scored during this match. All proceeds from this match will go towards SPD's early intervention programme.

3) Entry Form & Team List Terms and Conditions

- a. Teams are required to submit their entries on the official entry form provided with their players **full names**.
- b. Each team is allowed to submit only **one entry per category**. Any additional entries will be placed on the waiting list.
- c. Slots are on a first-come, first-served basis.
- d. All team players' names must be submitted **before the closing date**.
- e. **Tournament fees are to be paid before the closing date. This can be done via Bank Transfer (DBS Current 004-021181-2) or PayNow (UEN S63SS0051C)**. E-Invoice can be accepted for MOE Schools.
- f. Each team shall register a minimum of 7 players and no more than 12 players.
- g. Any changes to the team list after the closing date must be accompanied by a valid reason (e.g. injury) and must be approved by Netball Singapore in writing.
- h. Registration can be submitted to events@netball.org.sg. Please allow 1 working day for our team to respond to you.
- i. You can call 6346 5063 Ext 104/120 to verify that your entry form and name list are received. **No appeals due transmission error shall be entertained.**
- j. **Tournament fees remain payable in the case of withdrawal after the closing date.**

4) Tournament Rules

- a. For the Deloitte Pesta Sukan Netball Carnival 2025, Netball Singapore Tournament Rules <https://www.netball.org.sg/event/netball-singapore-tournament-rules/> shall apply.
- b. Umpires will be applying the latest INF new rules 2024 for all categories (including the school categories):

- c. Each player is only allowed to play for one team in each category.
- d. Netball Singapore reserves the right for the arrangement of fixtures and playing format.

5) Categories

- a. The carnival will be divided into 7 categories – 14&U, 17&U Schools & Clubs, 23&U Women, Women Social, Women Open, Mixed Open and Corporate Mixed Open.
- b. Registration is limited to 60 teams per day.
- c. Should there be fewer than 7 registered teams in any given category, Netball Singapore reserves the right to cancel the category without prior notice.

6) Eligibility for 14&U, 17&U Schools & Clubs Category

- a. 14&U Schools & Clubs – Players born in the year 2011 or after.
 - b. 17&U Schools & Clubs - Players born in the year 2008 or after.
- Please bring along your identification document for age verification by the Tournament Official.

7) Eligibility for 23&U Women Category

- a. Players born in the year 2002 or after.

8) Eligibility for Mixed Open Teams

- a. A minimum of 1 and maximum of 3 male players are allowed to take the court at any one time. The male players must play either a GS or GA; GK or GD; C, WA or WD. One male player per area of court.

9) Eligibility for Corporate Mixed Open Teams

- a. This category is open to commercial companies/entities and government ministries/statutory boards only.
- b. Team lists are to be verified by the company's Human Resource department.
- c. All players must be employees of the company. If players are found not to be employees of the team's company, the team shall be disqualified from the event.
- d. A minimum of 1 and maximum of 3 male players are allowed to take the court at any one time. The male players must play either a GS or GA; GK or GD; C, WA or WD. One male player per area of court.
- e. A maximum of 2 national players will be allowed per team.

10) Scoring and Time Keeping

- a. Central timing will be kept by Netball Singapore.
- b. Point System – Win 2 points, Draw 1 point, Loss 0 points and deduction of 2 points for awarding a Walkover.

11) Event Administration

- a. Random checks of players' identities may be conducted during the event.
- b. Protests must be submitted in writing within 48 hrs of the incident and must be accompanied by a protest fee of \$50.00.
- c. Netball Singapore reserves the right to change the date, time, and venue when necessary, without prior notice.
- d. If the carnival cannot be completed in time during the reserve day, the games will be stopped, and the final results will be determined by a penalty shootout amongst those teams still in the running for the finals. 4 shooters from each team will have 1 shot each from a designated point decided by Netball Singapore. In the event of a draw after the 4 shots, the highest drawn teams will continue shooting in a sudden death format (1 further throw for each team using the same 4 shooters in rotation) until the winners are determined.

12) First Aid

- a. First-aiders and ambulance will be on standby during the event.
- b. Players are advised to purchase personal accident insurance.

13) Liability

- a. Netball Singapore and our sponsors shall not be liable for any accidents, injuries or loss of personal property suffered during this event.
- b. Netball Singapore and our sponsors have the right to use any photographs, motion pictures, recordings, or any other record of the event for any legitimate purpose, including commercial advertising.
