COMPETITION RULES & REGULATION (BADMINTON)

1. RULES

- 1.1 According to the Laws/Rules established by the Badminton World Federation (BWF) and as directed by the Singapore Badminton Association (SBA) (www.bwfbadminton.org & www.singaporebadminton.org.sg) and,
- 1.2 General rules of GetActive Singapore and Singapore Youth Olympic Festival for Youth categories.

2. CATEGORIES & ELIGIBILITY

3. EVENT VENUE & SCHEDULE

The matches will be held at Heartbeat @ Bedok between 19 July to 2 August 2025.

Note: all above may change once the entries are finalised

4. EVENTS & FORMAT OF PLAY

- 4.1 The list of events shall be as follows:

S/No	Event	Remarks
1	Community Team Event	Mixed Doubles Master (40 year old & above, born in the year 1986 or earlier) Men's Doubles Open Mixed Doubles Open Minimum 6, Maximum 9 players per team Repetition of players will not be allowed for the community category

Note: Any event/s, with less than 8 entries may be cancelled.

4.2 Team Registration & Format

A team must register the following minimum number of players:

Event	Minimum No. Registered Players	Maximum No. of Registered Players	Remarks
Community Team	6	9	Each team must comprise at least two-thirds of its players that are residing in the GRC Cluster

4.2.1 No players can register in more than One (1) Team Event in Pesta Sukan 2026 Badminton Competition. If a participant is found to be registered with more than one team in the same category for a particular sport after the registration closing date, the participant will be disqualified from Pesta Sukan 2026. No substitution or replacement will be allowed

4.2.2 No replacements will be entertained.

4.3 The preliminary round for all categories will be played on a round robin group stage based on 1 set of 30 points scoring system. Top players / team from each group will advance to the next round of knock out stage.

4.4 The knock out stage will also be played on best of 3 games on the 21 rally point system. This is subjected to the final entries.

4.5 FINALS & 3rd / 4th PLAYOFF

The winners of Semi-Finals Round will enter the Finals Playoff to play for the Gold and Silver position of the competition. The losers of Semi-Finals Round will be awarded Bronze Medals (Joint-Third) by default.

5. WALKOVER

Any player/pair who fails to report to the umpire at the specified court, the match will be declared a walkover after a 5-minute grace period (time start once umpire on court) and all points will be awarded to the opponent.

6. RETIREMENT

Any player/pair who decides to retire due injury will have retain their points at point of retirement and concede all remaining points of the match to their opponents. For example, should a match be retired at 5-3 (5 being the score of the retiring entry), that would mean final score 5-21 (in a single 21 point game) or 5-30 (in a single 30 point game) or 5-21, 0-21 (in a best of 3 games of 21 point if it is in the first game).

7. WITHDRAWAL

Any player/pair who withdraws from competition at any point will be removed from the competition and all scores shall be deemed null and void.

8. DISQUALIFICATION

- 8.1 Player/s will be disqualified in the event of unruly conduct or cheating.
- 8.2 The Organiser reserve the right to disqualify player/s at its discretion and take further disciplinary action that could be in the form of a term ban in GetActive Singapore Competition Series.
- 8.3 Disqualification just prior to start of a tie will result in conceding walkover and walkover would mean conceding 0-30 (in a single 30 point game) or 0-21 points (in a single 21 point game) or 0-21, 0-21 (in a best of 3 games)

9. EQUIPMENT & ATTIRE

- 9.1 The organiser shall decide the competition grade shuttlecocks to be used for this competition.
- 9.2 All players must be appropriately attired for the matches. Players shall wear non-marking shoes during the competition.
- 9.3 All double players from the same team are encouraged to be in uniformed attire for the single elimination stage onwards.

10. REPORTING

- 10.1 Players/Teams are advised to register their attendance at least **45 minutes** prior to their scheduled match time. Scheduled matches can be called in to play up to **10 minutes** earlier if the preceding matches end well ahead of schedule.
- 10.2 For Team events, the team line up must be submitted to no later than **30 minutes** prior the scheduled match.

- 10.3 Participant(s) must bring along and produce either his/her valid Singapore pink or blue identity card or student pass with NRIC number.
- 10.4 Participant(s) who are non-Singapore Citizens residing in Singapore must bring along and produce a valid Student Pass or Passport. Failing which he / she will not be allowed to play.

11. REGISTRATION

- 11.1 Team Managers/Captain shall be the point of contact of the team
- 11.2 Late entries will not be entertained. Incomplete submissions shall be rejected.
- 11.3 PA Staff In-charge to send out name lists of two GRC winning teams to PAHQ respective District Officer prior to competition (submission deadline to be advised by PAHQ to PA Staff In-Charge).
- 11.4 No registration fee is required for Pesta Sukan Community category
- 11.5 Team Managers should NOT submit name lists directly to SportSG without notifying the PA Staff IC and/or PAHQ District Officer.
- 11.6 Resubmission of name list prior to competition should have a valid reason (i.e. if a player falls sick or has an injury and is unable to participate in Pesta Sukan Community category, the Team Manager should submit Medical Certification as proof, along with the updated name list). SportSG has the authority to accept or reject the new name list.
- 11.7 List of Possible Reasons for Change of Player (examples can be added or removed if not appropriate; we can follow Pesta Sukan R&R if available):
- i. Medical reasons
 - ii. Reports for National Service
- 11.8 Any resubmission of name list requests will NOT be accepted after fixtures are drawn and/or publicised on the website.
- 11.9 Any resubmission of name list requests within 24 hours prior to the actual competition is not permitted
- 11.10 Pre - Competition briefing will be emailed to Team Managers.

12. PRIZE MONEY & MEDALS

- 12.1 Prize Monies
- A minimum of 8 registered teams is required for any event to be eligible for prize monies.
- 12.2 Prize Monies for Pesta Sukan 2026 will be transferred to Winners of Individual

events or Team Manager via PayNow.

- 12.3 To access PayNow, participants can use the participating bank's existing internet banking platform or mobile banking app.
- 12.4 To receive money via PayNow into their bank account, participants need to register for PayNow service using their Mobile Number and/or Singapore NRIC/FIN (One-Time Registration).
- 12.5 In the event that the Prize Winner (Individual/Team) authorize an alternate payee to receive the prize money on his/her/team behalf, upon providing the alternate payee's details, the Prize Winner has confirmed that upon payment by Sport Singapore to the alternate payee, Sport Singapore shall be discharged of all obligations and liabilities to the Prize Winner for payment of the prize money.
- 12.6 In the event where Prize monies are not claimed by 30 Sept 2026, Sport Singapore reserves the right to forfeit the prize monies.
- 12.7 Medals will be awarded to the top 4 winners of each event with at least 4 participants/Teams;
- 12.8 If there are only 3 participants for the event, 'minus 1 rule' applies, i.e. only 1st & 2nd will be awarded with medal but no prize money;
- 12.9 If there are less than 4 participants/teams, participants may choose 1 of the following options:
- **Option 1** - Participants may withdraw and receive a full refund
 - **Option 2** - Participants may continue with the competition but will not be eligible for prize money. Medals will be awarded based on the 'minus 1 rule'.
 - **Option 3** - Participants may opt to join another category which they are eligible for.

13 COMPETITION JURISDICTION

- 13.1 The Organising Committee reserves the right to interpret or amend the rules and regulations of the competition at any time. Notifications of such changes will be posted on the Pesta Sukan 2026 official website. All participants are advised to visit the competition website frequently for any notices or changes to draws or schedules.
- 13.2 While reasonable precautions will be taken, the organisers, its servants and agents will not be responsible or in any way liable for any death, disability, personal injury, loss of property or any other loss howsoever arising from any cause whatsoever at any time during the course of this competition.
