

**PESTA SUKAN 2026  
COMPETITION RULES & REGULATION – SWIMMING**

Venue: OCBC Aquatic Centre

Date: 19 – 21 June 2026

**1. Rules**

- 1.1 Guided by the Rules and Regulations as directed by the Singapore Aquatics (SAQ) and in accordance with the Rules and By-laws of World Aquatics (AQUA) where applicable.
- 1.2 Governed by General Rules and Regulations.
- 1.3 Performance times achieved in the Competition can be used as Qualifying Entry Times for SAQ Long Course Competitions in 2026.

**2. Pesta Sukan 2026 Age Categories & Eligibility**

- 2.1 **Age is computed as of 31-Dec-2026**

- 2.2 The Swim Teams can be from:
  - 2.2.1 Community Sports Clubs
  - 2.2.2 Swimming Clubs affiliated to SAQ
  - 2.2.3 Primary or Secondary School Swim Teams
  - 2.2.4 Swimming Teams from ITE, Polytechnics and Universities
  - 2.3.5 Swimming Schools run by swimming instructors
  - 2.3.6 Group of swimmers forming their own Swim Teams
- 2.3 Singapore Citizen, Permanent Residents and Foreigners residing in Singapore are eligible to participate.

**3. Pesta Sukan 2026 Registration**

All Participants are required to make the payment for the entry fee individually at the links below **by 5<sup>th</sup> June 2026.**

Entry Fees for Individual Events:

- Youth: \$15.00 per swimmer
- Adults & Masters: \$20.00 per swimmer
- Participants are allowed to take part up to Maximum of Five (5) Individual Events in his/her Age Category

### 3.1 Registration Procedure for Participants from SAQ Affiliates – Individual Events

Age groups of Masters relay events are as follows:

3.5.1 Only registered swimmers with individual events in Pesta Sukan are allowed to compete in the relay events.

3.5.2 Swimmers may “swim up” in older age group categories for relay events (for all youth + adult categories).

3.5.3 For Adult 18 Yrs to 29 Yrs relay categories, swimmer above 29 years old may “swim down” to compete in the adult category if the total age of relay team members does not add up to 120 years (*minimum age of masters relays*).

3.5.4 Swimmers must compete in relays only under their originally registered club or unattached status.

3.5.5 Mixed teams comprising swimmers from different clubs or a combination of unattached and club swimmers **are not permitted**.

## 5. Competition Format

- 5.1 The Pesta Sukan Swimming will be run in a timed finals format in 10 Lanes Pool setup from fastest to slowest
- 5.2 Competitors (regardless of age) shall be placed in graduated time order, fastest to slowest in 10-lane pool based on the following age groups:

Seeding Order for the respective events		
Youth	7 to 12 yrs old	<b>Fastest to Slowest in the respective age-groups</b>
Youth	13 to 17 yrs old	
Adults & Masters	18 years and over	

## 6. Viability of Events

### 6.1 Individual Events:

- For an event to be viable there must be a minimum of **4 Registered Swimmers**. However, if there are only 3 or 2 Registered Swimmers, the event will proceed with a minus one rule for the award of medals.

## 7. Awarding of Medals

- 7.1 If there is a tie in any of the top 3 positions, the medals will be awarded, in accordance with AQUA General Rule GR 9.7.2.1 and GR 9.7.2.2 as follows:

### 7.1.1 In the case of two (2) equal times:

- For 1st position: 2 Golds, no Silver, 1 Bronze
- For 2nd position: 1 Gold, 2 Silvers, no Bronze
- For 3rd position: 1 Gold, 1 Silver, 2 Bronzes

### 7.1.2 In the case of three (3) equal times:

- For 1st position: 3 Golds, no Silver, 1 Bronze
- For 2nd position: 1 Gold, 3 Silvers, no Bronze
- For 3rd position: 1 Gold, 1 Silver, 3 Bronzes

- 7.2 Prize Money will be awarded after the entire competition concludes and will be awarded only to the Top 3 overall performance of each individual age category.

## 8. DNS and Withdrawals for Pesta Sukan Swimming 2026

- 8.1 During competition, any swimmer who fails to report for the event will be considered as Did Not Show (DNS). A swimmer, having entered the venue, is also considered as DNS if he/she fails to be at the Starting Block.

## 9. Swimwear

9.1 The Championship will be conducted in accordance to AQUA's Rules:

BL 8.2: In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces. No additional items, like arm bands or leg bands shall be regarded as part of a swimsuit.

BL 8.3: From January 1, 2010 swimwear for men shall not extend above the navel nor below the knee, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials.

## 10. Disqualification

10.1 The Competition will use the One Start Rule. Any swimmer who starts before the starting signal shall be disqualified. If the race has started before the disqualification is declared, the race shall continue, and the swimmer(s) shall be disqualified upon completion of the race.

## 11. Protest

11.1 Protests are possible:

- a. if the rules and regulations for the conduct of the competition are not observed,
- b. if other conditions endanger the competitions and/or competitors, or
- c. against decisions of the referee; however, no protest shall be allowed against decisions of fact.

11.2 All protests shall be considered by the Meet Referee.

11.3 If conditions causing a potential protest are noted prior to the competition, a protest must be lodged before the signal to start the race is given.

11.4 Protests must be submitted in accordance with the following:

- a. In writing, with the supporting facts
- b. With a deposit of **S\$200.00** enclosed
- c. Submitted to the Meet Referee by Affiliate Team Leader. No proxies will be entertained
- d. Submitted within thirty (30) minutes following the conclusion of the respective event

11.5 If the Meet Referee rejects the protest, he/she must state the reasons for his decision. The Team Leader may then appeal the rejection to the Jury of Appeal, whose decision shall be final.

11.6 If the protest is not upheld, the deposit shall be forfeited

11.7 The Organiser's decision to any protest shall be final.

## 12. Rules & Regulations

The Rules and Regulations as depicted above are current at the time of printing or posting on Pesta Sukan 2026 website. The Organiser reserves the right to add, delete and/or vary the said rules and regulations at any time as it deems fit.

Any amendments to the Rules & Regulations will be posted on Pesta Sukan 2026 website.

## 14. Coaches/Team Manager Accreditation

Swim Coaches who wish to apply for an accreditation pass to be on deck during Pesta Sukan must be an NROC Member with a valid status.

Team Managers must be minimally 18 years old based on date of birth to be allowed a team manager pass.

SAQ Affiliates are required to send in the names of their coaches and team managers (min age of 18 years old based on DOB) with their entry files to secure a pass.

Accreditation is non-transferable and the meet organisers reserve the right to confiscate the pass and ask individuals who misuse the pass to leave the venue in lieu of the safety of all participants.

## 15. Others (for Members of SAQ Affiliates)

For participants who registered for the Pesta Sukan Competition as the members of SAQ Affiliates, the performance times achieved at the Pesta Sukan can be used for consideration to qualify for future local / national meets and will be uploaded onto the SAQ sanctioned database for ranking purposes. These participants must also pay the 2026 SAQ Annual Swimmer Registration Fee via the SAQ membership by **5<sup>th</sup> June 2026**.
