

2026 Pesta Sukan Xiangqi Competition (Individual)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Background

Pesta Sukan is a premier sporting festival that promotes community engagement and celebrates the diversity of sports in the lead-up to National Day. The Singapore Xiangqi General Association is pleased to partner with SportSG to reintroduce Xiangqi to this iconic event—honouring tradition while championing strategic excellence in a dynamic, collaborative setting.

2. Objective

To celebrate Singapore's 61st anniversary of independence; to promote Xiangqi as one of the sports in the festival; and to encourage traditional cultural activities.

3. Organising Bodies

- i. Singapore Sports Council (SportSG)
- ii. Singapore Xiangqi General Association

4. Competition Venue

Bishan Clubhouse Sports Hall

5. Eligibility Criteria

Open to Singapore citizens, permanent residents, employment pass holders, or student pass holders.

6. Registration Process

Participants must register through the official SportSG website. Late registrations or incomplete forms will not be accepted. The registration deadline is 30th June 2026.

7. Competition Categories

Category	Age Restriction
U9	Born in 2017 or later
U12	Born between 2014 and 2016
U16	Born between 2010 and 2013
U21	Born between 2005 and 2009
Open	No age restriction
Veteran	Born in 1966 or earlier

8. Prizes

SportSG will award cash prizes and medals to the top 3 winners in each category.

To encourage participation, the Singapore Xiangqi General Association will extend awards to the top 6 players in each category (cash prize amounts are subject to SportSG regulations and will not be disclosed here).

9. Competition Format

The tournament will follow a Swiss System format with 7 rounds (tentative).

Rules: Governed by the World Xiangqi Rules published by the World Xiangqi Federation.

Time Control: Each player has 15 minutes with a 5-second increment per move. A player who exceeds the time limit will be declared the loser.

Late Arrival: Players arriving more than 10 minutes late for a round will be considered to have forfeited.

Forfeiture: Players who forfeit two rounds will be deemed to have withdrawn from the tournament.

Players must report by 9:00 AM on the day of the event.

11. **Player Conduct**

Players are expected to uphold sportsmanship and complete all rounds as scheduled.

Attire: Players must dress neatly and appropriately. Singlets, shorts, or slippers are not permitted in the competition area, except for children under 12 or those wearing school uniforms, who may wear shorts.

No smoking is allowed in the competition venue.

Electronic devices are strictly prohibited. Players must switch off mobile phones upon entering the venue. Using or answering a phone during a match will result in an immediate loss. A phone ringing will result in a warning for the first offense and a loss for the second offense.

Players may not bring mobile phones to the restroom during the competition. Violations will result in a technical foul.

Cheating will result in severe penalties and public notification upon verification.

Players must remain seated at their designated boards and may not wander (e.g., to observe other matches).

Upon completion of a match, players must report the result immediately and leave the competition area. Post-game analysis or photography in the venue is prohibited.

No food or drink is allowed in the competition area.

12. **Right to Amend**

The organising committee reserves the right to amend these rules and regulations at any time as necessary.

1. 背景

8. 奖项

SportSG 将为各组别前三名颁发奖金及奖牌。为鼓励参与，新加坡象棋总会将为各组别前六名颁奖（奖金数额依 SportSG 规定，不在此公布）。

9. 比赛赛制

- 采用 瑞士制，共 7 轮（暂定）。
- 规则：遵循世界象棋联合会公布的《世界象棋竞赛规则》。
- 用时：每方 15 分钟，每步加 5 秒。超时判负。
- 迟到：超过 10 分钟未到场者视为弃权。
- 弃权：累计弃权两轮者视为退赛。

- 严禁携带电子设备。手机须关机。比赛中使用或接听电话者立即判负。手机响铃：首次警告，第二次判负。
- 比赛期间不得携带手机进入洗手间，违者判技术犯规。
- 作弊将受到严厉处罚并公开通报。
- 参赛者须在指定棋桌就座，不得随意走动或观战。
- 比赛结束后须立即报告结果并离开赛场。禁止赛后复盘或拍照。
- 禁止在赛场饮食。
